- This year's K of C State Convention has been moved to the Bangor Hilton Inn on April 22<sup>nd</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup>. G.K. Bob M would like to have 2 delegates attend, as they can both vote on proposals (delegate forms will be available soon), fee is \$400 per person, with the council offsetting the cost (in motion to be made later tonight). There is a separate agenda for any wives attending. Itinerary to be sent to brother Knights after received by G.K.
- Our pastor, Fr. Dan Greenleaf, has asked all Brother Knights in our parish to participate in their church's baptisms, welcoming the families to our parish and providing rosaries for the parents and children (parents receive black & white ones, while children receive blue or pink).
