# How It Works:

## **Contestants:**

Make your favorite chili or chowder – there are no restrictions on the type of chili or chowder that you can make. Please make at least one crockpot of it so that there is enough for the judges and for the participants to try your creation. Please have an ingredient list available in case anyone needs to check for food allergies.

The judging will start at 5:30 PM on September 16. Doors will open around 5:15 PM. The K of C will provide the tasting cups, bowls, spoons, etc. We will also provide rolls and beverages.

Participants will vote for their favorites in each category (chili or chowder). Each participant will have 3 ballots to cast for their favorite chili(s) and chowder(s). Each participant can choose to award their ballots for just one in each category, or up to three of their favorites. The winners will be chosen by which chili and chowder has the most ballots.

## **Participants:**

People who would like to enjoy the chili and chowders produced are encouraged to show up at 5:30 PM as well and sample any / all that they would like to try. As noted above, each participant gets 3 ballots to vote for their favorite chili(s) and chowder(s). Most importantly, this is an opportunity to enjoy some good food and fellowship at a relaxed and fun event!

Contestants do not have to pay to enter, but participants are asked to contribute \$10 per person. Contestants can and should be participants too!!

Contestants and participants can register at the door, but pre-registering is preferred to help us plan for the number of attendees.
